

## **INVITATION FOR BID**

Sealed proposals will be received for the Austin Airport Apron Expansion project, addressed to the Lander County Engineer, 825 N 2nd Street, Battle Mountain, Nevada 89820 **until 8:30 am local time on May 8, 2014**, and then will be publicly opened and read. Bids received after the time fixed for the opening will not be considered.

**A pre-bid meeting will be held on site at Austin Airport pilot's lounge at 3:00 pm, local time, April 23, 2014** for interested contractors, subcontractors, and suppliers. Attendance by prime contractors is highly recommended.

The airport will construct approximately 11,500 square yards of new General Aviation apron. This project includes excavation, grading, drainage pipe, base material, bituminous asphalt, and pavement markings.

The proposed contract is subject to Equal Employment Opportunity (EEO) and Federal Labor and Wage Rate Provisions. The EEO requirements, labor provisions, and wage rates are included in the specifications and bid documents. Each bidder must supply all of the information required by the bid documents and specifications. Each bidder shall furnish the OWNER with satisfactory evidence of his competency to perform the work contemplated with the bid.

Lander County reserves the right to reject any and all proposals, waive any informalities, postpone the award of the Contract for a period not to exceed ninety (90) days, and accept the proposal that is in the best interest of the OWNER. The award of the Bid is contingent upon the approval of Federal funding.
